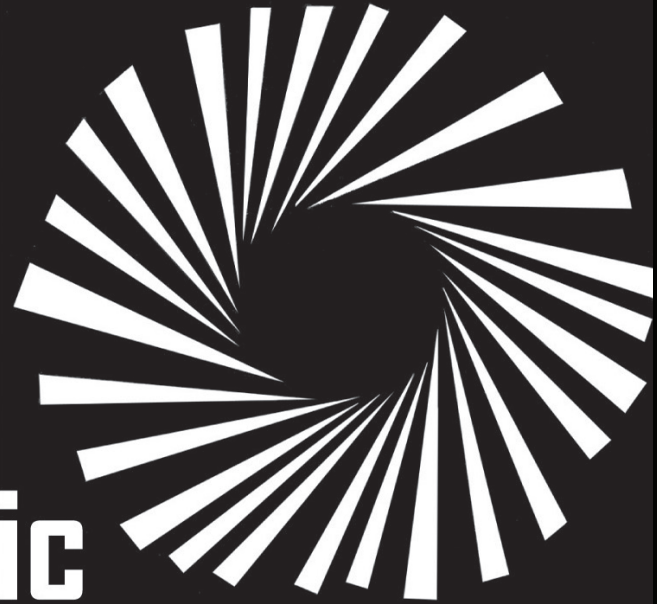

JURORS

Stephen Shore

Stephen Shore is the second living photographer to have a one-man show at the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York. He has also had one-man shows at MOMA, International Center of Photography, George Eastman House, and Kunsthalle, Dusseldorf among others. Shore has received fellowships from the Guggenheim Foundation and the National Endowment for the Arts and is widely published. He is also the chair of the Photography Department at Bard College in Annandale, NY.

Harvey Stein

Harvey Stein is an eminent photographer, teacher, lecturer, curator and author based in NYC. He teaches currently at the International Center of Photography and the School of Visual Arts, both in NYC. He has had over 70 solo shows, and his work is in the permanent collections of George Eastman House, Museum of Fine Arts Houston, Brooklyn Museum, ICP, and many more. Stein is represented by 8 major galleries and is the Director of Photography at Umbrella Arts Gallery, NYC.

Open to applicants over 18 years of age

Entry fee is \$40 for 6 images (\$30 to Garrison Art Center members - Membership info on web site)

Requirements:

Completed entry form available at garrisonartcenter.org

6 photographic images on CD (no slides accepted)

Additional images may be submitted at \$5 per image.

Files must be JPEG format readable on PC and MAC computers

CD must be labeled with Last and First name of artist.

Each image should include: Title, medium/technique, date of work, framed dimension.

A one-page resume and artist statement included as a Word Doc.

All photographic mediums and subjects accepted

Works: Must have been completed within the last 3 years

Must measure no larger than 30" x 40" or 1200 square inches including frames

Must be framed, ready to hang

Must be matted in white, framed with a simple, gallery style (black, white or aluminum)

Must not have been exhibited previously at Garrison Art Center

Submissions that do not comply with all the above requirements will be disqualified without refund of entry fee.

Aug. 30 - 31	Selected work to ARRIVE at Garrison Art Center between 10am-5pm
Sept. 3	Opening reception and announcement of awards 6-8pm

Sept. 27 - 28	Pickup unsold work (see shipping below)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All work must be for sale. **Garrison Art Center will retain 50% of the sale price.** The Art Center is not responsible for the loss or damage of works while in transit. Storage charges will apply for work not picked up by September 28, 2010. The Art Center reserves the right to reproduce accepted images on our website and in any advertising associated with this exhibition. All work selected for exhibition must be framed, ready to hang. Garrison Art Center will provide the opening reception, marketing and advertising for the exhibition.

The Art Center has the right to refuse work which differs from the original submissions and selections by jurors.

Submission of work and application indicates acceptance of conditions stated herein.

SHIPPING

Deliveries of accepted work must be received at Garrison Art Center between the hours of 10am and 5pm. Work which is being shipped should be well packed in substantial, reusable

cardboard containers. Works will be returned in their original packaging material. Artists are responsible for all shipping charges to and from the exhibition, plus any insurance while the work is in transit. Artists should send a return label and return postage in the form of stamps if shipping by USPS or remit the appropriate prepaid shipping forms for delivery by a designated shipping company. Any work selected for the exhibition which when received arrives in wooden containers, arrives late or damaged, is sent collect or without sufficient return postage will be returned to the artist prior to the exhibition.
