GARRISON ART CENTER AWARDED \$49,500 BY THE NEW YORK STATE COUNCIL ON THE ARTS

Mara Baldwin, 2026 Visiting Artist receives \$10,000 grant

DECEMBER 9, 2025, GARRISON, NY – Garrison Art Center (GAC) announced today a grant award totaling \$49,500 from the New York State Council on the Arts (NYSCA) to support the nonprofit arts and culture sector. Along with this general support grant, Garrison Art Center has also been awarded an additional \$10,000 to support Artist Mara Baldwin, Garrison Art Center's Visiting Artist for 2026. Through New York State's continued investment in arts and culture, NYSCA has awarded \$80.9 million in FY 2026 to arts and culture nonprofits across all 10 regions and a historic number of artists.
